Brent and Margaret grow corn and soybeans and have been outstanding conservationists for many years. They enrolled their marginal cropland in the RIM Reserve in 1989. Conservation practices on the RIM easement include: a wildlife tree planting, wetland, and native prairie. Other conservation practices installed by the Reese's include: a grassed waterway, buffer strips, farmed wetland area, and no-till. The Reese's have recently adopted precision farming into their corn and soybean rotation to minimize fertilizer inputs. Practices include: grid soil sampling, variable rate fertilizer application, and tissue sampling.
